DOD EMALL is a full service web-based e-Commerce site that allows registered users to acquire goods from commercial and government sources for Federal, State and Local Governments as well as other authorized buyers. FedMall, an exciting, new easy-to-navigate platform that has the look and feel of a commercial website, will replace DOD EMALL in First Quarter FY17. Users will have access to the same functionality in FedMall that DOD EMALL provides today, just on an updated, easy-to-use interface.
